CRANFEST AUGUST 17th and 18th!

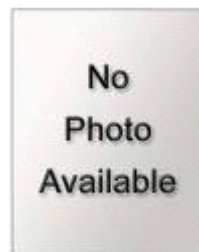
It will be a busy few weeks here at Cranberry!
